- 4. When addressing the Board, speakers are requested to state their name and address from the podium and adhere to the time limits set forth.

Started January dealing with lots of different types of issues: crisis, trauma, and lock down. **We need to add the Board members to our Parent Square notification system so they can be informed when an emergency happens. Cameras have been a great asset to help investigation of incidents on campus.

We are working on the safety project update in the front of the school – almost finished with the gate. Also looking at a visitor system that requires visitors to scan their ID and check in when they come on campus.

Changed our morning system – due to the new gates in front. All students have to enter through gate on Hawes (not the front of the school). They are given a tardy slip until 8:30 in the back, and after 8:30 – they have to come through the office to get their tardy. We have opened up the gates on Delno as well to help students enter and exit. We will be adding additional cement pathways for these gates in the future.

HOPES Awards are on 1/30/2024 – with varied times by grade level.

Report from Curriculum and Instruction Director – Mr. Sprattling
